I am an Indian citizen. SCHEME FOR COMPASSIONATE APPOINTMENT UNDER CENTRAL GOVERNMENT is to grant appointment on compassionate grounds to a dependent family member of a Government servant dying in harness or who is retired on medical grounds, thereby leaving his family in penury and without any means of livelihood, to relieve the family of the Government servant concerned from financial destitution and to help it get over the emergency. Compassionate appointments can be made up to a maximum of 5% of vacancies falling under direct recruitment quota in any Group C post. The appointing authority may hold back up to 5% of vacancies in the aforesaid categories to be filled by direct recruitment through Staff Selection Commission or otherwise so as to fill such vacancies by appointment on compassionate grounds.
