3. Whose cases were processed under the provisions of **DoPT guidelines on Technical Resignation**.

For each such case, kindly provide the following details:

- Name (or anonymized unique identifier, if disclosure of name attracts Section 8(1)(j)),
- Designation and Grade Pay/Pay Level held at the time of resignation,
- Date of resignation,
- Name of the Department/Ministry joined,
- New designation and Grade Pay/Pay Level joined,
- Whether past service was counted for pension, pay fixation, and other service-related benefits,
- Whether such resignation was accepted as "Technical Resignation" by the competent authority.
