**Minutes of First Meeting of State Co-ordination Committee comprising of GST authorities from the State and the Central Tax Administrations held on 30.11.2023**

First meeting of the State Co-ordination Committee comprising of GST authorities from the State and the Central Tax Administrations chaired by the Chief Commissioners, Central GST and Chief Commissioner, State GST was held on 30.11.2023 at NCRB Statue Circle, Jaipur. The meeting was attended by the following officers:-

2. Ms. Anupama Saksena, Nodal Officer of the State Co-ordination Committee, welcomed all the officers. The Chief Commissioner of Central Tax emphasized on the need and benefits of regular interaction with the objective of sharing of information and taking suitable measures for efficient tax administration for the State of Rajasthan. The Chief Commissioner, State Tax endorsed the views of the CC, Central Tax.

3. Further discussion took place as follows;

- (a) **Data sharing on important cases of evasion , knowledge sharing and promote coordinated efforts in checking fake ITC cases, curbing tax evasion practices, modus-operandi detected in Investigation;**
- (b) **Data sharing of important audit paras/ cases & modus-operandi detected in Audit:**

Both points were taken simultaneously for discussion. The details of important cases booked by CGST, Jaipur Zone and important audit paras raised by Audit Commissionerates of CGST Jaipur Zone were exchanged with the State Tax Officials as per Annexure 'A'.

- (c) **Maintaining and updating contact details of field level officers and other GST related matters:**

The contact details of field officers of both CGST & SGST were shared. It was decided to update the directory by including details of local Police Station, District Administration, Nodal Officers of Banks also.

**(d) Issues requiring a change in Act/ Rules/ Notification/ Form/ Circular/ Instruction/ improvement on GST portal, etc., to the GST Council Secretariat and the relevant Policy Wing of the CBIC/ GSTN/ DoR :**

No such issue was taken up.

**(e) Issues pertaining to taxpayer facilitation as well as taxpayer grievances and conducting outreach programme:**

It was decided to conduct joint outreach programme at least once in a quarter for taxpayers' facilitation and addressing their grievances.

**(f) Discussion on GST related petitions before any legal forum to arrive at a uniform stand by the Central and State GST Administration**

The CC, CGST suggested the CC, SGST to examine the need of becoming a party in the matter of M/s. Foundation of Media Professional W. P (Cr.) No. 395/2022. The issue involved in the said petition is seizing of digital evidences. The outcome of the Petition will affect the State Tax Authorities also.

**(g) Discussion for Co-ordination in the matters related to Investigation/anti-evasion proceedings so as to ensure that on the same issue, investigations in respect of taxpayers are not undertaken by multiple administrations:**

It was in principle agreed upon that the taxpayer should not be subjected to multiple investigation by multiple enforcement agencies. However, in cases where the issue involved is different, it will be decided on case to case basis by the field formations.

**(h) Discussion for coordinated verification drive for suspicious tax payers at local level :**

It was decided to capture data of registrations taken during three months, during transit checks of vehicles carrying Iron & Steel scrap, tiles and other evasion prone commodities. Such registrations should be taken up for physical verification on priority.
