Subject: SAMVAAD : September 2023

I am glad to have joined as Chief Commissioner of CGST & CX, Jaipur Zone on 21.08.2023. I have pleasant memories from my first stint at Rajasthan. I hope to build on my previous experiences and look forward to working with you all once again.

2. The Zone has collected a revenue of Rs.1,708 Crores for the month of August, 2023 which is a rise of 8.45% over the corresponding month of previous financial year. Upto the month of August, 2023, there is an increase of Rs.302 Crores (3.47%) as compared to the last F.Y. We need to gear up ourselves to realize our target of Rs. 23,300 Crores for the F.Y. 2023-24.

3. I am glad to share that CGST Commissionerate, Jaipur has booked a seizure of Tobacco Products i.e. Kamla Pasand Pan Masala, Rajshree Pan Masala, Safal Zarda etc. valued at Rs.1.50 Crores against M/s Aditya Sales Agencies, Jaipur and recovered tax and penalty of approx. Rs.52 Lacs so far. In this case unaccounted Indian currency of Rs.22.63 Lakhs was also seized. In addition, the Commissionerate has also booked two cases of fake invoices with a recovery of Rs.95 Lakhs so far. Further, CGST Commissionerate, Jodhpur have effected a recovery of Rs.7.45 Crore in the month of August, 2023 in the case of M/s Siemens Gamesa Renewable Power Private Limited, Jaisalmer.

4. DGGI, Jaipur have also booked three cases in the previous month. In one case of wrongful availment of ITC on fake invoices of Marble Blocks/ Luffers received without supply of underlying goods. Detection of Rs.15.08 Crores and recovery of Rs.9.08 Crores has been made from M/s Baba Super Minerals Pvt. Ltd. and M/s Baba Minerals. Further, on issue of non-payment of GST for rendering taxable services by M/s Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur, a case has been booked with detection of Rs.30.53 Crores and recovery of Rs.3.64 Crores. Another case has been booked against M/s Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India Limited with a detection of Rs.22.49 Crores. We need to take note of these cases and tone up our intelligence in these areas too.
